## **Kayaks, Canoes & SUPs Currently Unavailable**

At Taboo Muskoka, your safety is our number one priority. As we head into the May long weekend, we've been closely monitoring Lake Muskoka's water temperature and, have made the decision to keep our watercraft, kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards, out of service for the time being.

### **Why does water temperature matter?**

According to Transport Canada and the Government of Canada's safe water practices, sudden immersion in cold water at or below 15°C is considered potentially life-threatening. Cold shock is most severe between 10–15°C, significantly reducing the ability to swim or make it back to safety in the event of an accidental capsizing. Lake Muskoka's current temperature falls within this range, and guest safety will always come before recreation.

We know paddling on the lake is one of the things that makes a Muskoka getaway so special and we look forward to welcoming you back to the water as soon as conditions allow.
